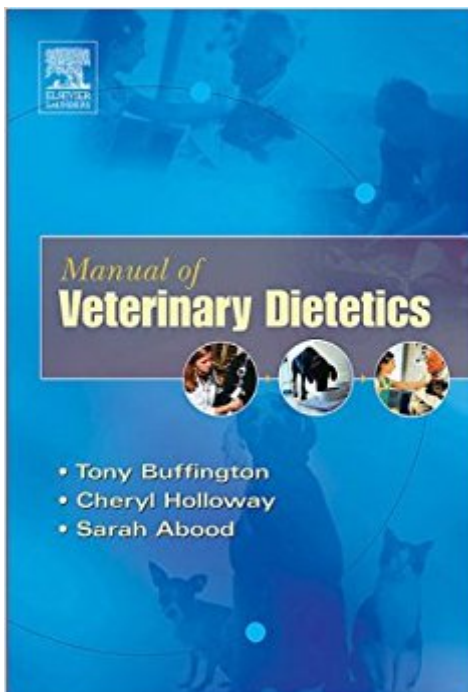


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Manual Of Veterinary Dietetics, 1e

It is a comprehensive guide to diet for healthy and diseased pet animals and does not restrict itself to commercial diets and indeed looks carefully at advertising claims, noting the paucity of evidence behind some of these. The authors note in their preface that they have chosen to present information in a different way to most pet nutrition books, because they intend to help practitioners, technicians and students, to help owners with their worries, rather than teach nutrition. This is clear from the opening pages and the book is eminently successful in its aim.
