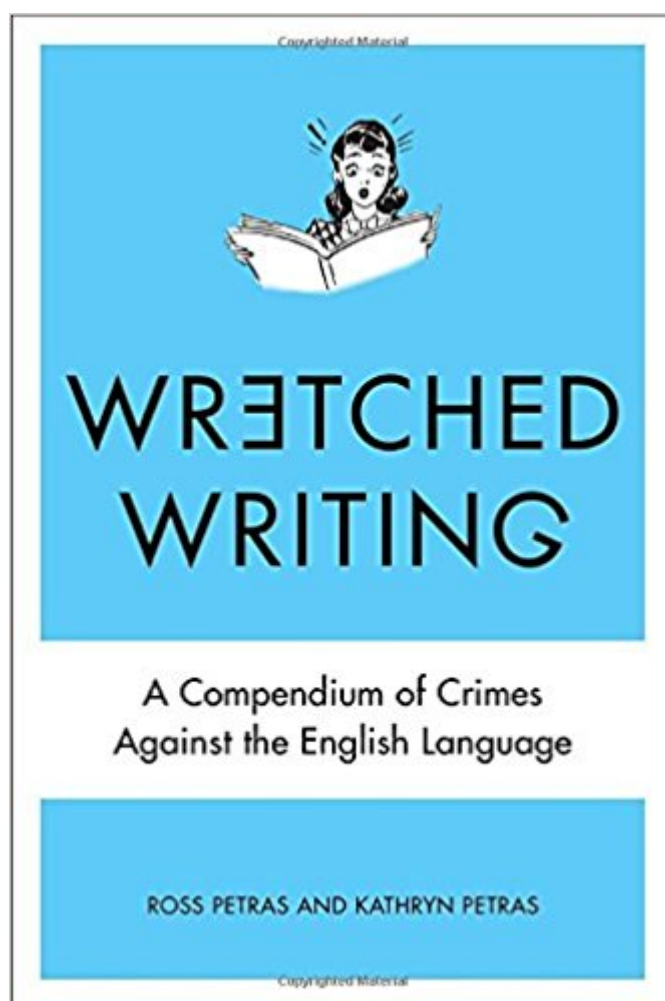

while most of the material covered in this book is very funny I was VERY surprised at how many entries are more then a little "risqué". If I wasn't expecting it some of the entries might be considered offensive and of a very adult nature. Aside from though, a very funny book and absolutely worth a look.

As an author, I sometimes question my ability to get ideas and descriptions on paper so they make sense and are interesting, without going overboard, so that my readers are tempted to groan and skim pages. This book makes me feel better about my own writing, but also serves as a warning... write well or risk becoming an entry in the next volume!

As another reviewer said, it is a long compendium of badly written sentences or paragraphs. It is mildly amusing, but I found it useful because I was doing a presentation on writing styles. I'm not sure that I would have enjoyed it without a purpose directly related to it.

Very funny and somewhat humbling...I found myself thinking, "I write like that." The style of criticism is very sarcastic--very enjoyable.

If you are looking for a rollicking tour through bad writing, this is not it. This e-book is more like a catalog of things to avoid, with useful examples. I'd recommend it as a reference for inexperienced writers.
