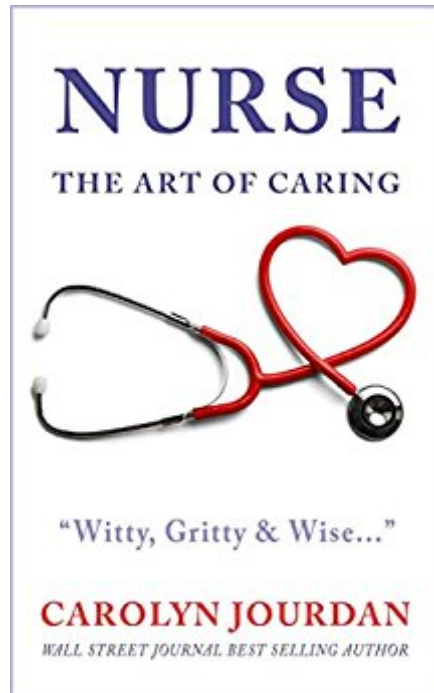




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Nurse: The Art Of Caring

Carolyn Jourdan's *NURSE: THE ART OF CARING* is a magnificent and page-turning glimpse into the profession of nursing. In a series of riveting interviews, Jourdan covers all the dimensions of nursing, from the battlefield and home front of World War II to the modern emergency room of today. Jourdan, who has written about the medical professions before (her wonderful memoir, *HEART IN THE RIGHT PLACE*, is about her experience returning home to help out at her father's medical practice in rural Tennessee; she also has two books about radiologists), is at her best in *NURSE*, plumbing the depths of the front lines of healthcare, wellness, and empathy through first-hand accounts from the dozens of nurses she interviewed for this book. I highly recommend it for any reader.

It does not take a special person to be a nurse.... It takes legions of special people of many kinds. That becomes clear when reading this book. Some are born to do hospice care to give help people shuffle off this mortal coil in peace and with dignity. Others help the most fragile premature babies overcome scary beginnings to thrive and grow. Nurses come in all sizes, shapes, colors, and temperaments but all share the common traits of compassion, empathy, and dedication that will never make them rich or famous. Carolyn Jourdan has opened her treasure trove to readers once again.
