Anni Taylor is absolutely brilliant in her debut book *The Game You Played*; an intense psychological thriller. I stepped out of my comfort zone of Fantasy and Sci-Fi for this and I am so glad that I did.

The Game You Played opened up a whole new world for me. In *The Game You Played*, we are painted a picture of a happy family in Australia. Phoebe, Luke and their son Tommy are at the park, enjoying themselves, like any other normal family would. When Tommy suddenly disappears,

Clever story about a child's disappearance and his parents' quest to investigate. Along the way we are presented with a very interesting cast of characters and their interconnected lives. Chapters are told as first-person accounts by the parents. Occasionally there is a chapter from the POV of another character. The needle of suspicion made some wild swings for a while then settled on someone. This being a psycho thriller, I had an inkling that the needle would swing in a different direction. It did. In a most believable and satisfying way. There were some awkward moments when the story slowed down while we were presented with new, seeming unrelated, information that became integral to the plot. Post climax, the story believability kind of went off the rails for me. It was hard for me to wrap my head around the psychic change that happened. In my life experience, such a change is also accompanied by lots of work and guided introspection by a willing person. None of that type of effort was described.
