Founded by Luftwaffe chief Hermann Goring and led by General Kurt Student, an officer of exceptional ability, the German airborne force was a crucial element of the new method of warfare it launched in WWII - blitzkreig. Referred to as "Hunters from the Sky", German paratroopers infiltrated Allied lines, fighting from the moment they hit the ground, seizing bridges, capturing airfields, and suffering losses of up to 50 percent. This book captures the history of the German Parachute Corps from its inception until its final battles and demise. It captures the personalities of its command structure and elite nature of this fighting Corps. For me it added greatly to my further understanding of the Nazi war machine. It is well written and highly valuable to any student of WW II.

"Hunters from the Sky" by Charles Whiting is about the German parachute corps 1940-1945. Written much from the perspective of the officers and men of the Luftwaffe, it does include Allied reactions. Starting out as an elite group early in the war, the group was reduced by irreplaceable loses by 1945. Very fascinating was the rescue of Mussolini from his mountain top detention.

This is a terrific book about the genesis of combat airborne forces. The techniques developed by the Germans during WWII are still used today as in airfield seizures and airborne assaults. But as always it is the leadership at the very top that determines final victory. The German paras are a perfect example of primo military forces being hamstrung and finally defeated by bad civilian leadership directing the generals as how they employ their forces and conduct warfare.

Interesting material on the early development of paratroopers. The book states that the Germans got the idea from the Rusian military and then the Allies copied the operational concepts and the development of special light equipment from the Germans.

The Germans made excellent use of airborne assaults during the early years of World War II. They were so successful that the Allies were forced to imitate them. This book tells of the tactics and the personalities of the German military men who made it happen.

Well researched and interesting account of the toughest fighting units in the German army. Pretty good balance between excess detail and actual actions of the paratroopers. Only Allied economic resources allowed them to defeat Axis Powers.

It is a good story with interesting background. Little ongoing unit history is organized well. No mention of unique airborne or para unique weapons was mentioned. While their work was a landmark in tactics, this book is somewhat incomplete. The author focused on the leaders and some inter German military politics. My THREE STAR is a gift. With some work, it could be a much better book. Also, it did not cover the subject in adequate detail and to some extent does the brave men a disservice.
