

Each chapter's photo gallery gathers both glorious panoramas and intimate close-ups, highlighting the incredible diversity of flora and fauna to be found in each area. Wild Seattle is sure to entice residents and visitors alike to explore familiar landscapes and discover surprising wild places in the "Emerald City."
