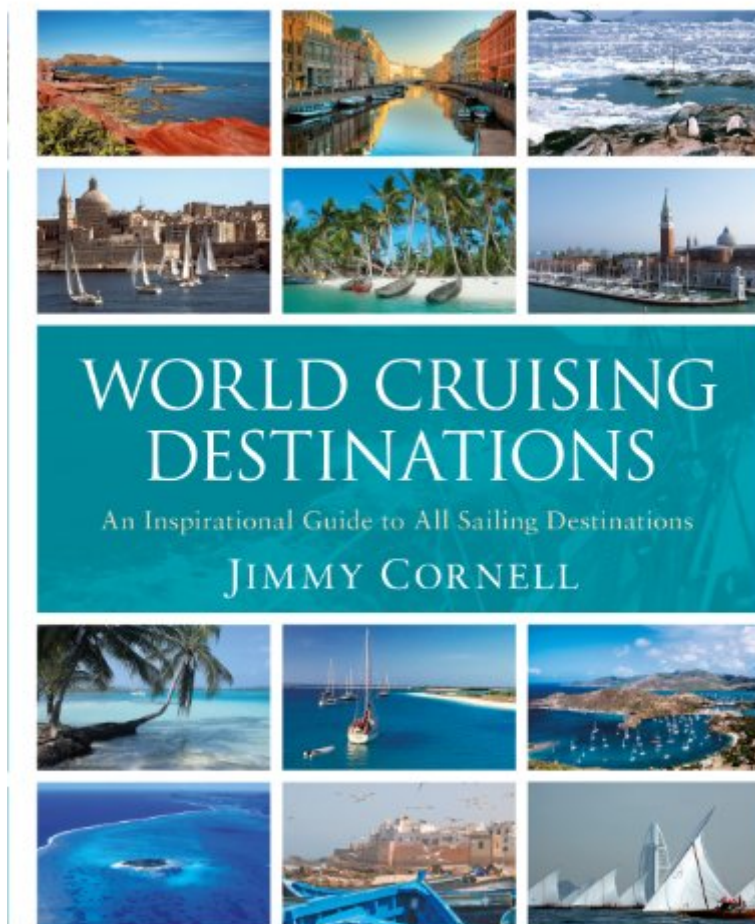

World Cruising destinations has all the important information for the world cruiser. However for those expecting a guide book or more information on the countries it covers will be disappointed. While each country does have an introduction and basic overview on whats on offer, the book is focused on the facts and figures needed to cruise the destinations, and for that it is a brilliant resource. It is filled with great pictures though, and is still of interest to people not cruising these destinations. Absolutely perfect and highly recommended for what it is, a valuable cruising reference. But others looking for a coffee table read should probably look elsewhere, aside from the beautiful photos throughout, it is not a travel guide.

This is a concise easy to read synopsis of major cruising destinations. While we are moving into an ever more electronic age for access of all content, I think it is important that hard copy references remain a viable source of information in case of the inevitable electronic failures.
