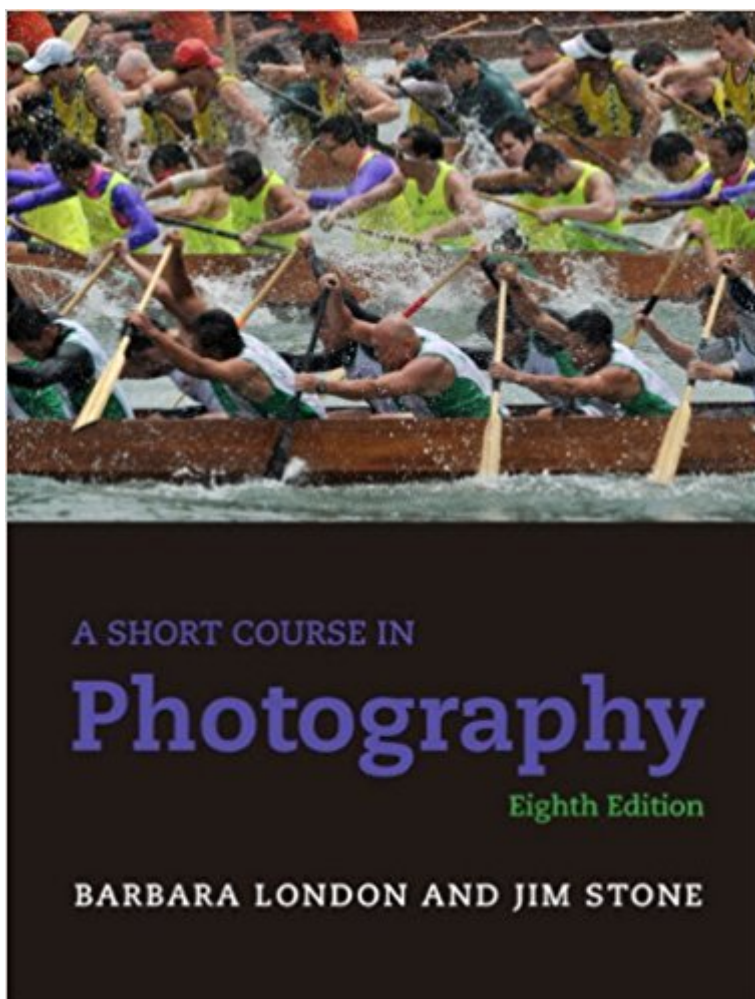

Do keep in mind this book is more focused on the film camera and the digital cameras are more of an extra but many of the topics in the digital version of this book "A Short Course in Digital Photography." If you are only planning to take a film course in photography then you can get a much cheaper version of this book since film has not changed in years, but if you want versatility and the option to take the digital course with the same book or just want to learn more about digital then you should get this book and save money.
