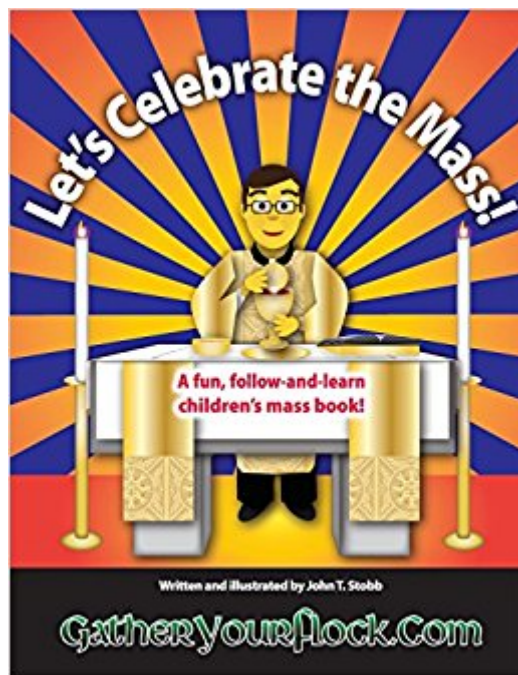

Mass with nice explanations for why we do what we do such as why we bless ourselves and why we genuflect. It has the words to some of the prayers or sometimes the beginning of the prayer to get the child started. I love that the last page of the book for the children is an example of the family living out being sent out into the world to be Christ for others. I also like that it includes detailed information on the very last page for parents and catechists about mortal sin, the need to be in a state of grace to receive the Eucharist, and the Eucharist as a sacrifice with references to specific sections of the catechism. These books are a very nice resource for anyone who wants to help make the Holy Mass meaningful for the whole family!!
