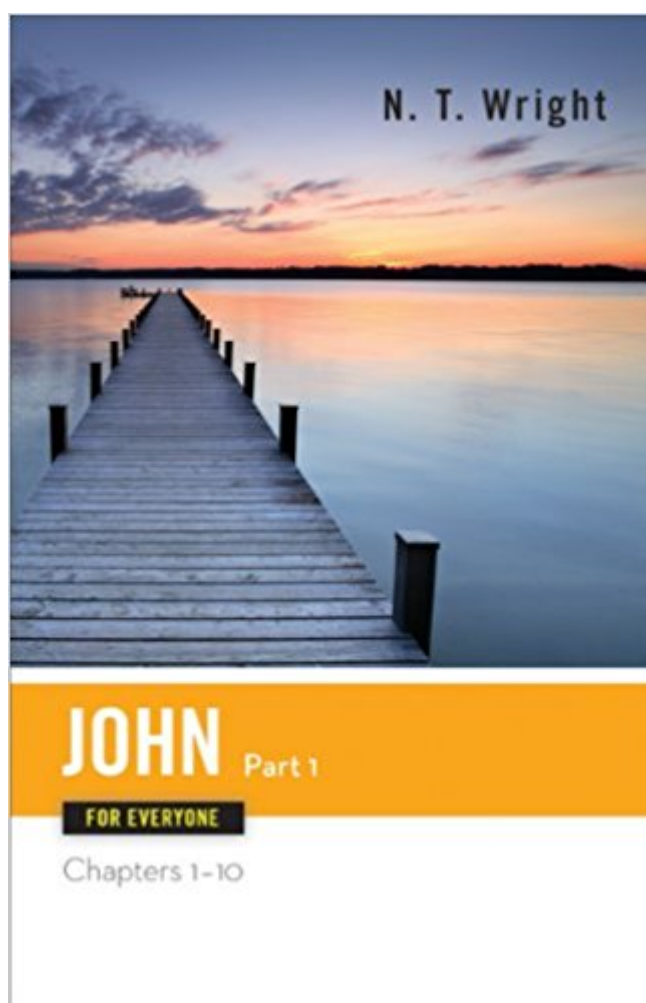

## Synopsis
