

Barbarians: How The Baby Boomers, Immigration, And Islam Screwed My Generation

Such a great book to read really keeps your mind open to seeing the world from someone else's point of view. I enjoyed the book very much and look forward to rereading it in the future.

"Barbarians" is a 90 page commentary on several groups that have positioned the up and coming generation for hardship, if not failure. In it, Miss Southern convincingly describes how hard-left academics, neocons, policies of unrestricted immigration, and radical Muslims have contributed to the economic and political degradation of Western civilization over the course of the last two generations. Moreover, she uses humor and extensive sourcing for everything she has to say. While I find her argument compelling, I do have two (small) quibbles: 1) I think she should have taken the time to outline a working definition of conservatism (as she does with neoconservatism and progressivism) because of her argument late in the text where she contends that the modern-day "right" is not conservative; and 2) the Crusades were undertaken by the West for much more practical reasons than she suggests. However, both of my reservations are minor, and in no case do I disagree outright with the facts she offers in support of her thesis. If you have read books of political commentary in the past, you may be expecting Barbarians to be a dry read. Let me assure you that it is not. While pretty well guaranteed to set the average SJW's hair on fire (a feature, not a bug), Miss Southern's book is engaging and makes for a very fast read. Perhaps the most telling recommendation I can make is that, after reading it on kindle, I ordered a hardcopy to add to my library.

Lauren states her case very clearly and backs it up with even clearer examples and reasoning that anyone can understand. I blasted through it in one sitting, and I came out of it feeling slightly better about the state of things, knowing that not everyone out there is part of the problem. This book has an undertone of doom, to be sure, but to pretend that isn't the truth would only serve to weaken us all. We have a lot of work to do.
