

So far some of it works really well and some not so much. It really depends on the dog, but this book is definitely helpful

I am amazed at how well I was taken by the description and reviews. This book is more like a multi-page pamphlet. A total of 36 Numbered pages. 6 pages of Introductions, 6 pages of examples of what dogs can do (seeing eye dogs, hearing dogs, etc), 22 pages of "training steps" (which are very vague and very short) and 2 pages of conclusions. One of the 2 pages of Conclusion is "Certification". Firstly the ADA has ZERO requirements of certification (which I will not begin my rant about how this failure is resulting in fake service animals making it hard for those who actually need one) and yet the text spends one whole page discussing the legal certification process. In reality a service dog should be independently evaluated for the handler and shown to meet the "good citizen" practices for public access. He could have at least fattened up his book with links and contacts for the third party agencies that will grant some independent verification that a dog will work well in public, work best for their handler and give the handler protections if their companion suddenly becomes a public menace. The "training chapter" gives very bare bones ideas of training without any attempt at longterm (more than a weeks worth of training). No ideas of how Clicking should be weaned, or how commanding a "come" should be extended or made more challenging for the dog. Then he goes just as vague into service specific training, though I will give credit that he at least touches on Deep Pressure Therapy for Autism/PTSD service animals that many texts don't even approach, but still lacks any details that I would consider a "Step-by-Step" guide to training. As an experienced MWD handler, I would compare this book to walking past the training grounds at Lackland AFB and believing now you know exactly the requirements to train an Explosive Detection Dog. I would never recommend this text to anyone that was actually serious about wanting to learn

fundamentals for training a service dog.

Put simply, this book is not a useful resource in any way. It gives almost no actual information, and much of what it does give is incorrect. Reads like a middle school research paper. The author clearly only wrote this "book" (all 29 pages) in an attempt to make a quick buck off people interested in the subject, not to educate or inform. The many 5-star reviews are obviously fake. Don't waste your time with this garbage.

I chose this rating because I had hoped for a little more information. I really appreciate the step by step instructions on some of the required tasks of a service dog. I can see myself adjusting the training I am doing with my dog and adding some skills while doing the basic obedience. For me it is difficult to determine how much and how fast I should be going with the training and what I should expect. I am still hesitant about clicker training. I'd like to know more pros and cons. All in all this is a helpful book and I'm glad I read it.

Not much to it. 33 pages, large print, First 5 pages are the introduction. Just no detailed information. Probably cost 50 cents to print and took a couple days. Very, very generic.

The book it's not very specific. It gives you a general idea of how it is to train a service dog but it is very vague at explaining the process.

I hardly think anyone would have a service dog trained after reading this. It just gives a basic description of some commands. Not exactly inspiring.
