

The Thief's Countess by Cecelia Mecca is an addictive and brilliantly written story of honor, duty and love. Book 1 in what promises to be an extraordinary series, "Border" series. See the prequel, "The Ward's Bride". Set against the Anglo-Saxon border in the 13th century (1271), Northumbria, England. What a great Medeval Romance! From the first page to the last, I was intrigued and glued to the pages. I couldnÃƒÂ¢t figure how Sir Geoffrey, a Reiver, who needs to reclaim his inheritance, who seeks his revenge and Lady Sara Caiser, a Countess, an extraordinary lady of good breeding, alluring and complicated, would find their HEA, with so much against them. However, Ms. Mecca manages to pull it all together in a dramatic and heart felt ending. I loved these two characters, they were so caring, honor bound and determined to make the best out of the hand life dealt them. Another winner of a story in this series! Geoffrey, a noble knight who lost his holding and lands to marauding Scots, has become a reiver living off the theft of cattle and belongings from the enemy. He and his uncle have traveled to Keshire Castle at the request of the Earl who had died to assist his daughter, Countess Sara, in securing her claim to her lands from unscrupulous relatives. Sara was engaged to another Earl before her father died and she is in need of protection until her intended bridegroom arrives back from the Crusade. When Geoffrey meets Sara, who is reluctant to accept protection from a reiver, the sparks start flying and their unlikely romance takes root. Both of

them fight their attraction for each other due to their familial promises and duties, but their love threatens to overcome their good sense and intentions. This is a wonderful romance full of angst and longings, betrayals, struggles and hope.

I just finished reading The Thief's Countess and was not disappointed. I came across the prequel which was being offered for free at the time so I downloaded and read it. I immediately searched for The Thief's Countess, but it hadn't been released yet. Once it was I scooped it up.
