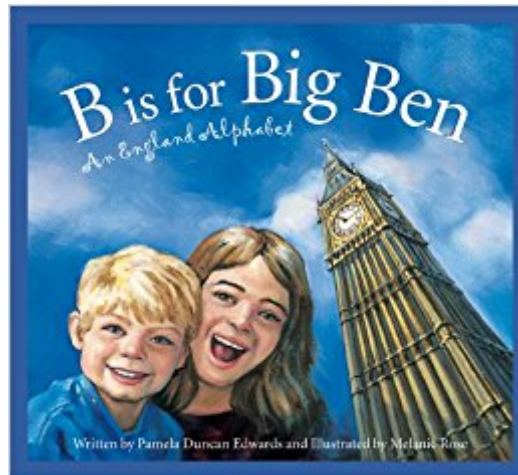




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B Is For Big Ben: An England Alphabet (Discover The World)
