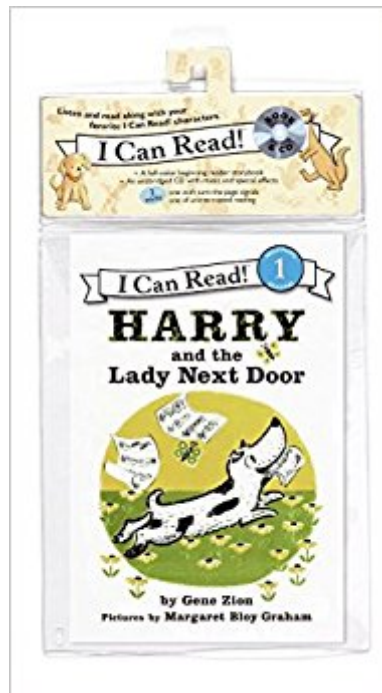

This book was just "okay" for us; it's a simple enough story about Harry not liking the singing from the lady next door. Through various means, Harry tries to deter the woman from singing, although his attempts are not particularly engaging and there is a bit of a disconnect in how he seems to think his substitute noise(s) will remedy the situation. Overall, not a bad book, but not one that is requested often or eagerly.
