

I can tell by reading this book that the author is an expert in the field and really knows what he is talking about. I also find it amazing how one generation like the baby boomer generation can have such an impact as they go from their youth and working years to retired adults. Here are some of the details that I especially liked in the book. Baby boomers, in youth there is an increase demand, which equals supply shortages and economic inflation. In old age they retire and consume less causing a downward adjustment in the economy and deflationary pressures set in. It is as simple as that. Facts like these have been known by economists for years, so why is it a shock when there is a recession? Why are people so surprised by poor economies when all the signs have been there for years? There will be no surprises and no shocks after reading this book.

This short book is reminiscent of Harry Dent, but is written in a less self-promotional and more level-headed and reasoned way. Which is to say that I found it a more satisfying read, even though the message is far from reassuring. The author puts a serious difficulty before us, one that we can't avoid, without offering any facile solutions.
