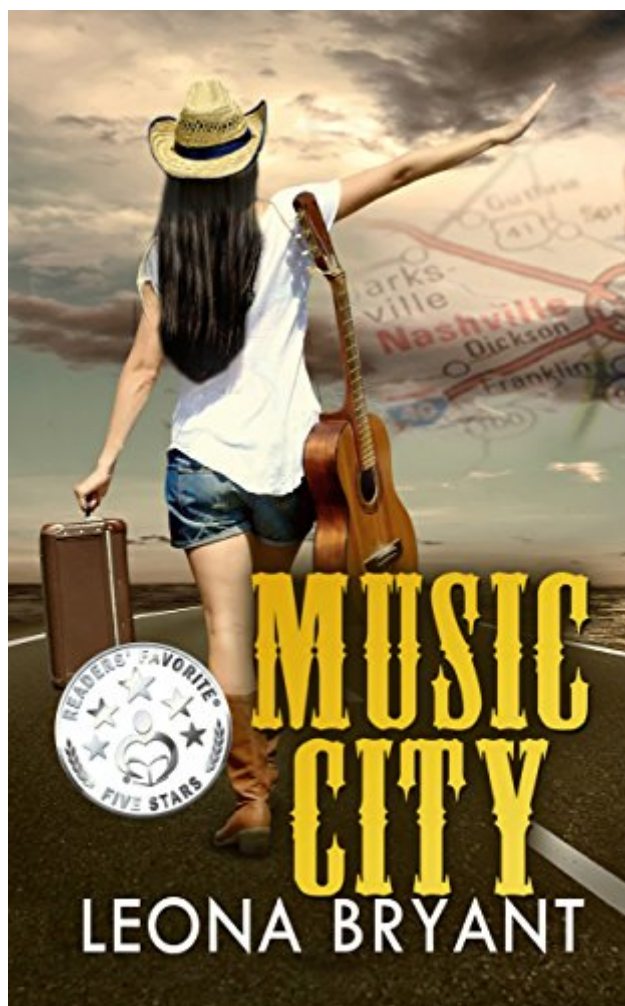


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Music City

Because out of the fog of anonymity came a person who changed her life forever and helped her eventually become the big-shot entertainer that she is now. But there's only one problem: thirty years, and Shelly still doesn't know who that stranger was. Now at the pinnacle of her career, Shelly finally resolves to clear up the mystery by hiring a couple of detectives to try and find that mysterious stranger. What follows is a meandering, touching story that is as much a journey into the self as it is about anything else. Music City is, for lack of a better word, enchanting. And then there's Bryant's writing the magic ingredient that has made this story compelling and beguiling. Bryant has a knack for getting under your skin and into your heart, the way she fleshes out the emotion of her characters is uncanny, the way she makes you sit there reading this book with your mouth hanging open.
