

Enjoyed the picture of Egypt, its culture and politics of that day. It presents a different picture of the Israelites in captivity than I had imagined, but it was enjoyable reading. This is a lengthy book and sometimes read more like a history book, but for the most part the characters were interesting, intriguing and made for some good reading.

I sorta felt sorry for Shepi at first but then what she did later I changed my mind.
