

In 2015, I entered 10 drafts on MyFantasyLeague.com. I only won one, but that mostly offset all my other losses. For 2016, I thought my success could increase if I just drafted more teams. And because I would only need to win two leagues to break even, I decided to draft 20 teams. I shelled out \$200. I won four leagues in finished in second in another, which means I hauled in a total of \$400 and a \$10 credit. In total, I finished in at least fourth in 11 out of 20 of the drafts. For 2017, I want to help new and veteran best-ball players win their drafts. I'm going to provide a review of my winning teams from 2016, who I drafted in three of my best-ball drafts for 2017, and I will also provide a list of players to draft in Round 10 and later at the quarterback, running back, wide receiver, and tight end position. Just to get to know me a little more, here are some of my accomplishments over the last several years:
*2014: Top-40 finisher in the 2014 RotoBowl and \$1,500 prize winner
*2015: Top-50 finisher in the 2015 Mock Draft Championships
2015: 1st in draft accuracy for quarterback rankings on FantasyPros
2015 & 2016: Magazine feature in The Fantasy Football Guide
2016: Missed out on receiving another \$1,500 prize in the Online Draft Championship by just six points, received free entry into 2017 Online Draft Championship as a runner up for my league
