

Grade 4-6-Sanford's careful research and lively writing style chronicle the birth and death of the Chisholm Trail. The end of the Civil War brought a booming economy, a demand for beef, and a need to move longhorn cattle from Texas to stockyards in Chicago. Eight chapters packed with information describe the development of the trail, the life of cowboys on it, hazards they faced, five different "Cowboy Capitals" that at various times served as the terminus of the trail, its eventual demise, and its legacy. Generally small, black-and-white photographs, drawings, or reproductions help to break up the narrative. The text is readable, well written, and accurate. Andrew Santella's *The Chisholm Trail* (Children's, 1997) provides short, basic information on the topic and Albert Marrin's *Cowboys, Indians, and Gunfighters* (Atheneum, 1993) provides more in-depth coverage of the development of the entire cattle industry and the clash between cowboy and Native American cultures.
