

up, a third was born, church-building projects loomed large, relational miscommunications snowballed and inner chaos reigned. I was somewhat bothered by the selected Bible verses. They can answer the questions, but make more sense if written in context. It is also necessary to buy the book since the study guide asks you to read the appropriate chapters in the book. Alone, the study guide is not that helpful. I also found that the whole study is more valuable in a small group setting rather than doing it alone. That way struggles and confusions and mis-understandings can be discussed in a supporting manner.
