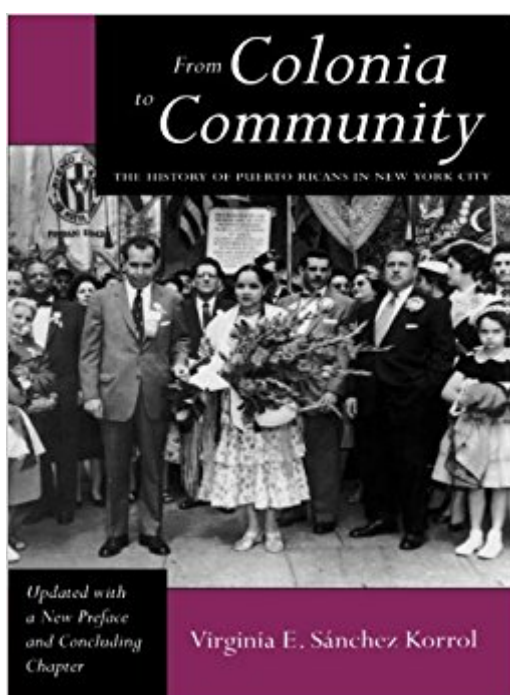


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From Colonia To Community: The History Of Puerto Ricans In New York City (Latinos In American Society & Culture)
