

## **Synopsis**

Corrie ten Boom was fifty years old when she began harboring Jews during World War II. She was imprisoned in a concentration camp, and after her release she traveled the world, proclaiming the gospel. What happened in those earlier fifty years to prepare Corrie for all that lay ahead? In *My Father's House* (over 250,000 copies sold) explains how God used life's small beginnings and everyday happenings to prepare Corrie for the suffering and victories to come. The eighth book of the Corrie ten Boom Library, it is the first in the series to focus on the years leading up to World War II and the events of *The Hiding Place*. More than merely a collection of memories from Corrie's colorful life, this book explores the human side of one of the most authentic Christian witnesses and the faith that kept her going strong. This book was previously published by Revell in 1976.

Fantastic book. Also links her childhood with her adulthood, as she reveals how her past prepared her for her work defying the Nazis. It contains short chapters

which can be read all in one sitting or little by little, as a devotional.

This book reveals more fully the sweet life the ten Boom family gave up for their unfailing love of God's chosen people. There are 20 or so photos included which help draw one especially into Corrie's adventurous life working with the mentally disabled and the years forming and leading Girls' Triangle Clubs and Camps and housing children of missionaries. Corrie led a very productive life and the book ends with this quote by her dear father, "When Jesus takes your hand, He keeps you tight. When Jesus keeps you tight, He leads you through life. When Jesus leads you through life, He brings you safely home."

Corrie got a FIRM foundation from her Father !

This was a believable story and had interesting parts, but did drag a bit here and there. However, it set the stage for Corrie ten Boom's second book, "The Hiding Place" which I also have and read. "In My Father's House" made reading "The Hiding Place" more understandable because it referred back to the first book in parts and I understood why a passage was written.
